To support this key objective the BCO has different committees which work under a number of remits including research, regional and international specific areas and the next generation of BCO membership.

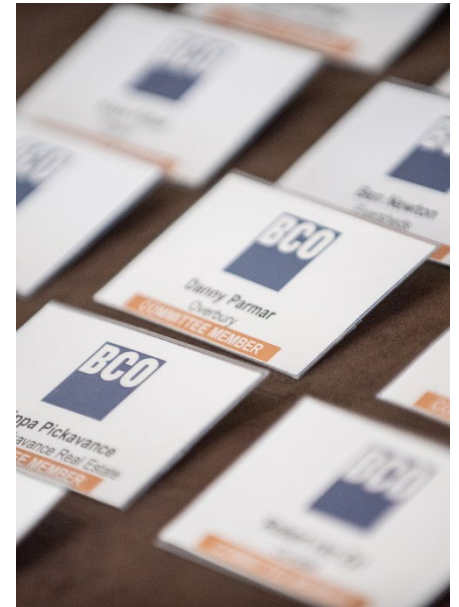
WHAT'S INVOLVED

The primary role of the **Regional Committees** is to promote the BCO regionally, by focusing on topics of local interest. They do this by organising a variety of activities, which are designed to complement the national work of the BCO. Activities include, but are not limited to:

- Promote the BCO to a wider regional audience.
- Deliver a varied calendar of topical talks and office tours across the region to share best practice.
- Disseminate knowledge through the regional launch of published BCO research.
- Encourage and foster collaboration with a view to creating and inputting into cutting-edge research documents, fitting into the wider BCO objectives.
- Deliver an annual regional awards programme to promote excellence in office space.
- Engage with the national [Committees](#), [Management Executive](#) and to influence BCO strategy.

Those wishing to join a regional committee **must be members of the BCO and able to attend regular committee meetings** (frequency depends on region but is generally monthly or bi-monthly).

Membership of each committee is reviewed on a regular basis to ensure that there is a good balance between the necessary skill sets required by each group. We cannot guarantee that you will be placed on a committee, but all applications will be put forward when a space becomes available.
